## STOOL GRADING CHART

1	Very loose, watery stool	
2	Pudding-like consistency, stool lacks cylindrical shape	
3	Very soft stool with some formed cylindrical shape	
4	Formed stool with cylindrical shape – some segmentation visible	
5	Formed stool with cylindrical shape and segmentation, easy to pick up	
6	Hard stool, spherical or cylindrical in shape
